604b Water Quality Management Planning Grants (MassDEP)	Funds watershed-based nonpoint source assessments and planning projects, including the development of watershed-based plans, water quality assessments, and design of green infrastructure.	Application closes in May 2026 (anticipated)
319 Nonpoint Source Competitive Grants (MassDEP)	Funds stormwater Best Management Practice (BMP) design and construction, stormwater utilities, feasibility assessments, and education and outreach.	Application closes in May 2026 (anticipated)
Environment and Climate OneStop (ECO) Grants (MA Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs)	Hosts a single application portal and review process for seven sustainability and resilience-focused grant programs, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Municipal Vulnerability Program Action • CZM Coastal Resilience • CZM Coastal Habitat and Water Quality • Cooling Corridors • Planning Assistance • Dams and Seawalls Removal • Culvert Replacement Municipal Assistance and Training 	Application closes in late February/early March 2026 (anticipated)

Community One Stop for Growth Grants (Executive Office of Economic Development, Executive Office of Housing and Livable Communities, and MassDevelopment)	Hosts a single application portal and review process for multiple grant programs that fund various phases of economic development projects, including community engagement, planning, site preparation, and construction.	Full application period closes in early June 2026 (anticipated)

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Culvert Replacement Municipal Assistance (MassDOT, MA EEA, DCR)	Funds the replacement of culverts in areas of high ecological value to meet structural and environmental design standards.	Application closes in February 2026 (anticipated)



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MassTrails (MassDOT, MA EEA, DCR)	Funds the project development, design, engineering, permitting, construction, and maintenance of recreational trails, shared-use pathways, and amenities that support trails.	Application closes in February 2026 (confirmed)
Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (US DOT)	Funds surface transportation infrastructure projects that improve safety, sustainability, quality of life, mobility and connectivity, economic opportunity, regional collaboration, and innovation.	Application closes in February 2026 (confirmed)
Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) (MassDOT)	Provides funding for two types of grants: Planning and Demonstration Grants for comprehensive safety action plans and Implementation Grants for projects and strategies identified in an Action Plan.	Application closes in June 2026 (anticipated)
