604b Water Quality Management Planning Grants (MassDEP)	Funds watershed-based nonpoint source assessments and planning projects, including the development of watershed-based plans, water quality assessments, and design of green infrastructure.	Applications open in August 2026 (anticipated)
319 Nonpoint Source Competitive Grants (MassDEP)	Funds stormwater Best Management Practice (BMP) design and construction, stormwater utilities, feasibility assessments, and education and outreach.	Applications open in August 2026 (anticipated)
Stormwater MS4 Municipal Assistance Grant Program (MassDEP)	Provides funding for projects that support requirements of the 2016 small MS4 general permit through resource-sharing partnerships.	Applications open in late Summer 2026 (anticipated)
Environment and Climate OneStop (ECO) Grants (MA EEA)	Hosts a single application portal and review process for seven sustainability and resilience-focused grant programs, including: • Municipal Vulnerability Program Action • CZM Coastal Resilience • CZM Coastal Habitat and Water Quality • Cooling Corridors • Planning Assistance • Dams and Seawalls Removal • Culvert Replacement Municipal Assistance and Training	Expressions of Interest open in Fall 2026 (anticipated)
Local Bottleneck Reduction Program (MassDOT)	Seeks to fund innovative solutions to modernize traffic signals and address congestion bottlenecks on local roadways to improve traffic flow.	Applications open now until August 7th, 2026!
Complete Streets Funding Program (MassDOT)	Provides technical assistance and construction funding for roadway projects, including redesigns, pedestrian crossings, traffic calming, connectivity improvements, and streetscape investments.	Applications open now until August 7th, 2026!
Shared Streets and Spaces Program (MassDOT)	Provides funding to municipalities to quickly implement improvements to plazas, sidewalks, curbs, streets, bus stops, parking areas, and other public spaces in support of public health, safe mobility, and strengthened commerce.	Applications open now until August 7th, 2026!
Community Culvert Program (MassDOT)	Provides funding to municipalities for the modernization, repair, replacement, removal, and improved resiliency of culverts.	Applications open now until August 7th, 2026!
Municipal Small Bridge Program (MassDOT)	Provides funding to municipalities for the replacement, preservation, and rehabilitation of eligible bridges, including both design and reconstruction.	Applications open now until August 7th, 2026!
